RE: TRANSFER OF THE MANAGEMENT, ADMINISTRATION AND

CLAIMS ACTIVITIES OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION SECURITY FUND TO THE NEW JERSEY PROPERTY-

LIABILITY INSURANCE GUARANTY ASSOCIATION

<u>P.L.</u> 2009, <u>c.</u> 327 transfers the management, administration and claims activities of the workers' compensation security fund ("Security Fund"). established pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 34:15-105 <u>et seq.</u>, to the New Jersey Property-Liability Insurance Guaranty Association ("NJPLIGA"). The Compensation Rating and Inspection Bureau ("CRIB") previously handled these duties, based on a delegation of authority from the Commissioner.

The Security Fund will remain a separate legal entity, but its operations will be administered by NJPLIGA effective March 1, 2010. NJPLIGA is in the process of amending its Plan of Operation to reflect these new responsibilities. Consistent with prior practice, workers' compensation insurers will remain subject to any required assessments for the Security Fund, and such assessments will be reflected in the workers' compensation manual rates filed by CRIB.
