ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WITH TEMPORARY RESTRAINTS

This matter having been opened to the Court by petitioner, New Jersey Property-Liability Insurance Guaranty Association (NJPLIGA), John Burke, Esquire appearing, and it appearing that Healthcare Providers Insurance Exchange (HPIX), a Pennsylvania insurer, has been declared insolvent and ordered liquidated, and it further appearing that there are causes of action pending in various counties throughout the State of New Jersey against insureds of HPIX, and NJPLIGA, in the discharge of its statutory obligations to insureds of HPIX has petitioned this Court for a stay of all proceedings pending in this State against those insureds until further Order of this Court and for a period of 120 days dating from January 12, 2018, the day FIFIX was declared insolvent and ordered liquidated, and it appearing that irreparable harm may result to insureds of HPIX if a stay is not entered, and due deliberation having been had herein, and for good cause having been shown;

IT IS ON THIS

ORDERED that all proceedings pending in the State of New Jersey in which HPIX is a party or is obligated to defend a party be, and hereby are, stayed until the return date of this Order to Show Cause; and it is further;

**ORDERED** that NJPLIGA shall serve a copy of the Verified Petition, Certification and Order to Show Cause upon HPIX or its liquidator; and it is further;

ORDERED that NJPLIGA shall arrange for the publication of this Order in the New Jersey
Law Journal, The Star-Ledger, The Asbury Park Press, and the Courier-Post as soon as possible
following its execution; and it is further;

ORDERED that all parties so objecting shall file papers with the Court by Monday, Just with copies to be served upon John Burke, Esquire, counsel for petitioner; and it is further;

ORDERED that reply briefs on behalf of petitioner shall be filed and served by and it is further;

**ORDERED** that a copy of this Order shall be served upon the Civil Presiding Judge and Civil Division Manager of each Vicinage in the State, and upon the Civil Practice Division of the Administrative Office of the Courts upon its execution; and it is further;

ORDERED that NJPLIGA shall supply to the Civil Practice Division, as soon as reasonably possible, a list setting forth the names of the cases which will be subject to the Order, identifying the HPIX insured in each case and, when available, the docket numbers, including County designations.
